

## A Message from the PSA

## Context: A "Ceasefire" in Name Only

November saw a shift in international diplomacy with a UN Security Council

resolution dubbed a "plan for peace."

However, for Palestinians, the month was marked by a continuation of the genocide, suffering, and a catastrophic humanitarian situation, including a dramatic surge in deadly settler violence in the West Bank and continued attacks in Gaza, Syria, and Lebanon.

- UNSC Resolution 2803: Adopted on 17 November and presented as a major intervention, it has in practice served to legitimize the ongoing genocide and illegal occupation.
- Ongoing Genocide & Forced Displacement: Since the resolution's adoption, over 350 Palestinians have been killed in Gaza. Israel's stated plan to build a "humanitarian city" over Rafah to facilitate "voluntary migration" is a policy of ethnic cleansing, condemned as a "concentration camp" model.

- Surge in West Bank Violence: Record-high settler attacks and intensified military operations in villages like Tubas, Tammun, and Jenin aim to displace Palestinians, confiscate land, and entrench illegal settlements.
- Dire Humanitarian Situation: Attacks on ~~frontier~~land, healthcare, infrastructure, and homes have caused an "unprecedented and catastrophic" collapse.
- Alarming Displacement Flights: On 13 November, a flight chartered by Al Majd Europe—a Zionist front organization for forced population transfer—landed in South Africa carrying 153 Palestinian passengers from Ramon Airport, Israel. This follows a similar flight on 28 October. We view these flights, facilitated under the guise of 'humanitarian evacuation,' as a direct ~~for~~ ~~re~~ ~~placement~~ ~~of~~ ~~plants~~ ~~outlined~~ by Israeli officials. Gift of the Givers together with solidarity organisations are providing urgent support to the arrivals, who are on 90-day visitor visas.

*OUR PREMISE: THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE HAS RULED THE OCCUPATION ILLEGAL. OUR SOLIDARITY IS BUILT ON ACTIVELY SUPPORTING PALESTINIAN RESISTANCE AND HOLDING PERPETRATORS ACCOUNTABLE, WHILE CONFRONTING ALL METHODS OF DISPLACEMENT.*

# PSA ACTIVITIES & CAMPAIGNS: NOVEMBER 2025

## 1. Solidarity & Advocacy Campaigns

### Defending Dr. Tlaleng Mofokeng

We have strongly condemned the African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights (ACHPR) and the African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights (HPCSA) politically motivated misconduct charges against UN Special Rapporteur Dr. Tlaleng Mofokeng. We demand a reversal of sanctions and a public apology, viewing this as an attack on a moral leader for her stance against genocide. ([download PSA statement](#))

### AI Baraka Divestment Campaign

We called on Old Mutual AI Baraka to divest from Glencore, a company implicated by a UN report in supplying coal to Israel and fuelling its "economy of genocide." ([read letter to AI Baraka here](#))



## 2. Media Activism & Accountability

Our persistent media watchdog work continues:

- We secured a victory in a Press Ombud case against biased reporting (BizNews, The Sunday Times, The Citizen).
- Lodged a new complaint regarding biased coverage of the Dr. Mofokeng case.
- Have three active complaints with the BCCSA against the SABC for privileging Zionist voices and unbalanced reporting.

### 3. Community Mobilisation & Fundraising

**Annual Fundraising Lunch** A successful event featuring panels with Dr. Haidar Eid, Dr. Tlaleng Mofokeng, Gift of the Givers, and activists from the Freedom Flotilla. Discussions focused on

global struggles, and how to sustain active solidarity.

**Weekly Rosebank Picket** This consistent Friday action has evolved into a vibrant space for intersectional solidarity, linking the fight for Palestine with struggles in Sudan, Congo, and against femicide in South Africa.

## 5. Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions

The PSA continues to work with the broader solidarity movement globally to isolate Apartheid Israel economically, socially and politically. The PSA is part of the international BDS National Committee through our affiliation to the SA BDS Coalition. The campaigns include calling on the South African Government to implement economic sanctions against the illegal occupation as per the ICJ measures. Some of the key campaigns includes:

- Energy Embargo: Together with solidarity organisations globally and in South Africa, PSA has a continuous focus campaign against companies such as Glencore and African Rainbow Minerals that are complicit in exporting coal to Israel.
- Targeted Boycott: Together with the SA BDS Coalition the PSA continues to create awareness within our communities to boycott key products. This link provides the list of the targeted boycott list. [Link](#)
